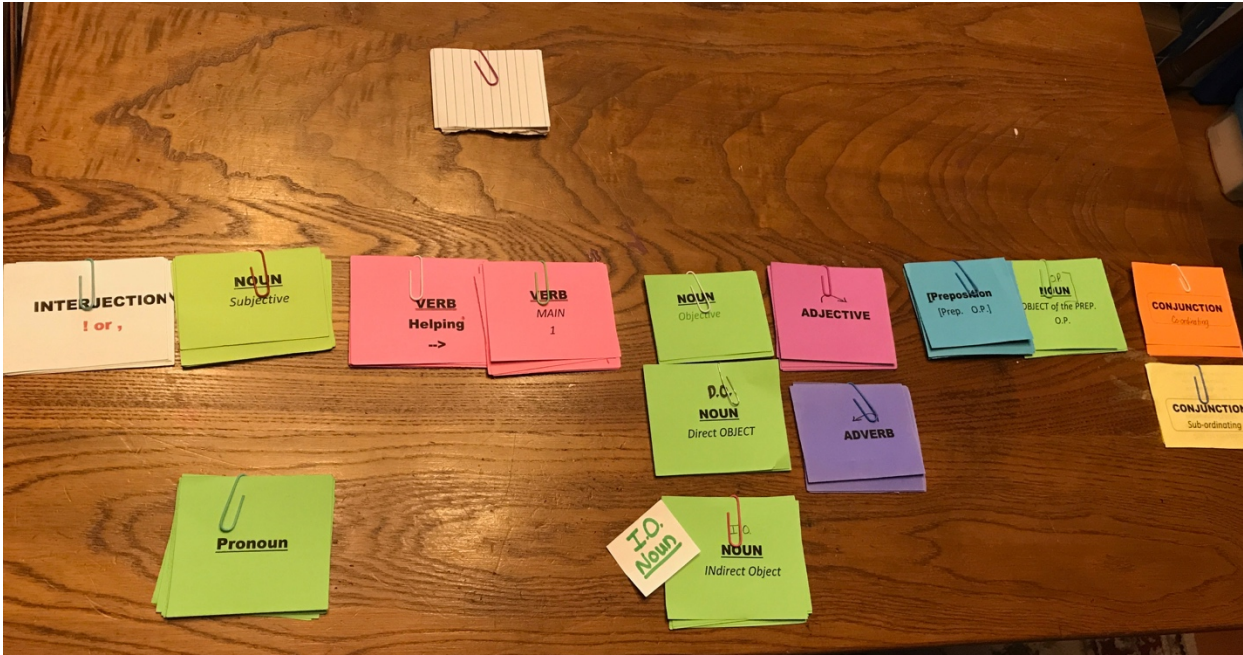

| (to) feel, | feels, | felt, | (have) felt, | (is) feeling |
| (to) grow, | grows, | grew, | (have) grown, | (is) growing |
