

Relative Pronouns

There are only 5 relative pronouns:

that which who whose whom

These will begin a **RELATIVE CLAUSE**.

The clause will have a subject and a verb:

The man got the job **that he wanted**.

The relative pronoun can stand in for the subject:

The man **that died** was my uncle.

PUNCTUATION: Essential or Non-essential

If the clause is **necessary**, ~~commas~~.

If the clause is **able to be omitted w/o harm to the meaning** of the sentence, **use** commas. ✓

The man, **who looks like Santa Claus**, is our pastor.

Relative clauses often use I construction.
